4th Sunday of Easter – 2023 - Good Shepherd Sunday

"The Lord is my shepherd..."

What is your dream in life? To be successful? To be rich? To be famous? But what do you think is the Lord's dream for you? And while we may have varying situations and opportunities in life, today as we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday, we hear Our Lord's desire for all of us: "I came so that they might have life and have it more abundantly."

What is this abundant life that Jesus promised? Ironically, it has nothing to do with accumulating material wealth nor with being famous nor being successful in this world, which has been a driving force for many. It is all about being right with God through faith in Christ and having the hope of eternity spent in His presence very much like the life spent by the sheep with their shepherd. Jesus is the Good Shepherd, who is ready to lay down His life for us, and continuously offering the opportunity to live our life to the fullest.

But the question is: "Are we ready to see ourselves as sheep of a shepherd?" I will admit, however, there is something a little disheartening about being described as a sheep. Because adorable as they may be, they are not the smartest of animals. But even more so It is difficult to admit our likeness to animals that so depend on a shepherd for survival. We are much more accustomed to being shepherds in control than sheep so in need of leadership.

So that at the end, we can only but join the author of the psalm today who wrote: "The Lord is my shepherd, there is nothing that I shall want. (Ps. 23)"
