

"Whoever loses his life for my sake will find it."

Certainly nothing surpasses the goodness and kindness of God. More so, no one can outdo God in his generosity. Is it not true that everything we have and are, comes from God.? And yes it all comes from him – loving us and caring for us unconditionally, sinners that we are. So how much more will He reward us should we choose to carry out His will in our lives?

Jesus assures us in the gospel today: "Whoever receives a prophet because he is a prophet will receive a prophet's reward, and whoever receives a righteous man because he is righteous will receive a righteous man's reward. And whoever gives only a cup of cold water to one of these little ones to drink because he is a disciple—amen, I say to you, he will surely not lose his reward."

But we are surely missing the point when we do something good solely for reward. As St. Francis of Assisi pointed out in his Prayer of Peace, "It is in giving that we receive; it is in dying that we are born to eternal life." Giving and doing something good, no matter how insignificant it may be, such as giving a cup of cold water, is in itself our reward because we become participant in the unfolding of God's kingdom.

And let us always remember that every good deed done to another person can very well be what we could be doing for Jesus who said: "Whoever receives you receives me, and he who receives me receives Him who sent me." Is not this the only reward that matters?
