15th Sunday of Ordinary Time – Year A - 2023

"A sower went out to sow..."

This Sunday's parable of the seeds, the sower and soil is a parable on HOPE.

First are the seeds. One must have hope that these seeds will sprout. Otherwise why sow it? Our hope is that this little seed will grow and blossom into a big tree or will yield a harvest of a hundred fold. And same is true with the seeds of goodness, truth and love. Our hope is that such seeds will flourish and overtake the whole world.

Second is the Sower. The sower must be a person of hope. who never grows tired of sowing even if he is not sure of the yield he would have. The sower will not give up for he has faith in the seed and the grounds that will receive it. And such is the Lord who will not grow tired sowing His words in man's heart. His hope is that it will bear fruit one day.

And third is the soil. As much as we put hope in the seed so must we have hope in the soil. The soil which is the heart of a believer may not be a rich soil now, but with a little cultivation, weeding, and composting it will be ready to receive the seed and yield a harvest of hundred, sixty or thirtyfold.

When hope thrives, miracles bloom!


