“The kingdom of heaven is at hand.”

Happy Father’s day!

This Sunday’s Gospel fits perfectly our Father’s Day celebration. Jesus calls his would-be-apostles and entrusted them with a mission to go to the lost sheep of the house of Israel and make this proclamation: “The kingdom of heaven is at hand.”

In the same light, to be a father is a sacred task that comes from God. It is not simply an obligation for the child or children that a man has begotten but a sacred calling from the Father who truly cares for every human person that is brought to this world. Being a father is a God-given mission. It is indeed a vocation.

And as the Lord Jesus chose not the “perfect and most gifted” but the “flawed and most ordinary” to carry out the mission, those called to be fathers can count on the grace that the Lord will send to fulfil their responsibilities and commitment.

This is also remind us that to be a disciple of the Lord is not so much about doing, but being. As disciples it is not about what we are able to accomplish or achieve but who we become as followers of Jesus. He is the Lord of the Harvest. It is His vineyard. It is His mission.
