I am the Way, the Truth and the Life,

And when we are worried, what do we do? Where do we turn for answers? Today the Gospel reminds us - "Do not let your hearts be troubled. Have faith in God, have faith in me." Jesus asks us to put our Trust in God, to put our trust in Him.

These words do not mean that we would no longer be encountering trials and difficulties. Rather, the Lord is telling us the proper attitude to take, "Trust in God". We know how worrying can eat our hearts and minds away from God. It wants to take the place of God in our lives.

And this "Trust in God" is anchored in the Lord's assurance when He said: I am the Way, the Truth and the Life, and no one comes to the Father except through me." As the Way, Jesus is not just giving us a spiritual map to guide us in our journey. Rather, Jesus is willing to walk with us and guide us to the Father if we will allow Him to do so. As the Truth, Jesus is not handing us a set of profound doctrines or teachings to learn. Rather, Jesus' loving relationship with the Father reveals the truth of His identity as God's beloved Son who can lead us to becoming God's beloved sons and daughters, And finally as the Life, Jesus is not promising us a successful or prosperous life but rather He is offering us the fullness of life to be shared with the Father in eternity.

Thanks to Our Lord Jesus, God is not a distant Father whom we will never know. Jesus gave the Father a human face that we can recognize and who lives amongst us.

"JESUS Thirsts for America", a 21-city, 3-year National Evangelization tour that began in November 2022 is coming to Oahu on July 15, 2023. Its purpose is to share the Gospel of JESUS CHRIST in such a compelling way that participants to be encouraged and strengthened to become more excited in expressing their faith. The "I Thirst" events include... Dynamic Teachings, Personal Testimonies, Inspiring Music, Healing, Prayer, Mass and Reconciliation which open participants to encountering the risen LORD.

5 National Presenters have been approved by our Diocese to minister in Hawaii: Dcn. Steve Greco, Barbara Heil, Dcn. Larry Oney, Andi Oney, and Kathleen Beckman. Their presentations are geared towards the love of the Sacraments, focusing on the Eucharistic Revival and encouraging people to not only be Disciples of JESUS CHRIST but to also lead others to HIM.

Movement organizer, Dcn. Steve Greco, is the Director of Evangelization and Faith Formation at the Diocese of Orange, and president of Spirit Filled Hearts Ministry, which engages in evangelization and support of the foreign missions.

Barbara Heil is a longtime protestant minister convert with experience ministering to the poor, in children's camps and inner-city missions. Heil discovered late in life that she had been baptized as a child in the Catholic Church. She received the Rite of Confirmation in 2013 and has since ministered around the world.

Deacon Larry Oney of the Archdiocese of New Orleans and his wife Andi Oney. Deacon Oney is the founder and president of Hope and Purpose Ministries in Louisiana, which he created in part to provide mentorship through the creation and distribution of Catholic materials in all forms of media.

Andi Oney, international evangelist and author, previously served in education for 12 years. In 2013 her life changed while attending an International Prophetic Consultation gathering of leaders in Bethlehem, Israel. While in Israel, she experienced a dramatic conversion as she prayed in the Upper Room in Jerusalem, believed to be the site of the Last Supper and Pentecost.

Evangelist Kathleen Beckman, a popular presenter on topics including the spiritual life, Eucharistic life, healing and deliverance ministry, Divine Mercy, Mary, and the spirituality of Blessed Conchita Cabrera. She is author of four best-selling books, "Praying for Priests," "God's Healing Mercy," "When Women Pray" and "A Family Guide to Spiritual Warfare". For twenty-five years, and in thirteen countries, through Catholic radio and television, writing and speaking, she has served in the Church's ministry of evangelization.

Bishop Larry Silva will celebrate Mass. Dominic Olaso (Head of the Diocesan Evangelization TaskForce) will emcee and lead the Praise & Worship.


