

Initially the disciples kept themselves inside the upper room because they were afraid the authorities will be also looking for them as disciples of Jesus. But the sudden appearance of Jesus made them more afraid. Were they seeing a ghost or has Jesus returned to reprimand them? "Why are you frightened, and why do doubts arise in your hearts?"

Fear and doubt are two words that can describe the reality of the people of today. There seems always something to be afraid of – that something can go wrong and cause harm or danger in one's life. Or that people are out there to trick or scam you. And these two are the very obstacles for one to bear witness to who Jesus is.

But Christ is risen. That means our greatest fear, the fear of the one thing we have no power to overcome, namely death, has been conquered. Death did not have the final word over his life; his resurrected body had the final word over his death. And since he is God and man, the resurrection means "God saves"; it means Jesus is our Savior. If we live our lives in him, and if we die in him, we will rise in him. And He reminds us: "You are witnesses of these things."

He does not say we can be or should be but rather we are witnesses. Like the disciples, we cannot run away from this responsibility. Are willing to say yes to this summon of the Lord?

This weekend our Parish is blessed with nearly 40 candidates who will receive the sacrament of confirmation. Let us pray that they be true and faithful witness of the Risen Lord.
