- Need to attend a pre-baptismal preparation class provided by parish. A Certificate of Attendance will be issued.

Godparents Qualifications:

- At least 16 years of age. One Male and/or One Female.
- Living the Catholic faith who received Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation. (Code of Canon Law, Canons 872-874).
- Parents of the child to be baptized cannot serve as godparents.
- Must attend the pre-baptismal preparation class provided by parish. If you are not from the parish, you may
 attend the pre-baptismal preparation class at the parish you are registered with. A Certificate of Attendance
 of class will be issued to you and must be presented to St. Joseph Church. (Valid for 3 years).
- If married, must be married in the Catholic Church. Those who are married outside the church or who are living together with their partner may not be godparents.
