



Sunday Reflection

Third Sunday of Easter (C)

April 18, 2010

Acts 5:27-32, 40b-41; Ps 30:2, 4, 5-6, 11-12, 13; Rv 5:11-14; Jn 21:1-19 or

Sharing a meal does more than just nourish our bodies. It helps to forge relationships and create intimacy. And so we take care to make the meals we share with families and friends special, with good food, atmosphere, and conversation.

It's no wonder then, that today's Gospel—like some of the other Easter stories—shows the risen Lord and his friends sharing a meal. These accounts remind us of the Church's celebration of the Eucharist—with good reason. Christians down through the ages have come to recognize the risen Christ in their midst, as the Scriptures are proclaimed and the eucharistic meal is shared. What we are celebrating in this Easter Season, the Paschal sacrifice of Christ—his dying and rising—is present to us in each Mass, with its saving power.

Do we take the Sunday Mass for granted? At our eucharistic gatherings this weekend, let's allow this Easter story to recharge our celebration. Imagine the thrill of encountering Jesus in a new way, marveling at the wondrous things he can do in our sight, gratefully accepting the forgiveness we need.

Tiana Montell

Call it a "three-peat"....For the third year in a row, Tiana Montell has qualified to a National level gymnastics competition. In 2008, Tiana became a member of the Region 2 team at the Junior Olympic National Championships held in Florida. At that competition, Tiana performed a release move on bars

that had never been done by any other athlete in national competition before and now the move is named after her in the gymnastics rule books and code of points. The "Montell" shows innovation and makes the crowd gasp every time she performs it.

In 2009, she attended the National Invitational Tournament in Seattle, Washington, where she was competing as an individual in hopes of being recognized as a potential collegiate athlete by gymnastics coaches from universities all over the country. This year, Tiana has again qualified to the Junior Olympic national championships to be held in Dallas, Texas, from May 6-9. Tiana qualified for the team at a recent regional meet in Auburn, Washington, with approximately 400 athletes participating throughout the weekend. In order to become a member of the team, Tiana needed to rank in the top 7 of her age group. The other members of her team are from the states of Washington and Oregon. Being a member of the Level 10 regional team attending the National Championships is the highest honor in the USA Gymnastics Junior Olympic program.






