Pastor's Corner:

17th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear brothers and sisters.

Peace in the Lord Jesus Christ!

In preparation for the changes that will begin this Advent, I would like to focus on the General Parish Catechesis, Part I (The Introductory Rites) of the Third Edition of the Roman Missal.

- 1. Perhaps the most obvious change occurs with the Greeting. When the priest says, "The Lord be with you," the people's new response will be, "And with your spirit."
- 2. There will be changes to the Confiteor that also reflect a more literal translation of the Latin, and included the words, "I have greatly sinned...through my fault, through my most grievous fault."
- 3. Another noticeable change is in the words of the Gloria. This too reflects a more literal translation of the Latin text: Glory to God in the highest and on earth people to people of good will. We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory, Lord God, heavenly king, O God almighty Father. The Gloria also includes another time honored description of Jesus as the "Only-Begotten Son."

These changes will be included in the missalettes or in other worship aides for our use. While they may be unfamiliar at first, overtime, they will become a part of us. Let us be patient with one another as we adjust to the new changes.


