Dear brothers and sisters,

Peace in our Lord Jesus Christ!

We see in the first reading this Sunday the call of Amos, a farmer, a shepherd, and attendant of sycamore trees to prophesy in His name. Amos responds to God's call but was forbidden to enter the Temple by the priest in Bethel. The words of Amos seemed out of place and unworthy of attention at a time when Israel was enjoying economic and political prosperity. But the prophet's message was a warning against conformity and contentment.

In the Gospel Jesus summons his disciples on a mission. They were instructed to take nothing on the journey except a walking stick and to wear sandals. They are to rely on God's generosity as they fulfill their mission.

The two readings help us to realize that God is calling us out of our comfort zones to take up the challenge of proclaiming His message to others.
