Pastor's Corner Dedication of the Lateran Basilica

Dear brothers and sisters

Peace!

Today is the Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome. You may be asking "Why do we celebrate a church in Rome?"

Very simple, the fact is that this church is the Cathedral of Rome, officially called 'the Archbasilica of our Savior' or Saint John Lateran Basilica. Many mistakenly think of the Basilica of Saint Peter in Rome as the pope's cathedral, but that is not so. The inscription on the plaques on either side of the main entrances of the Lateran Basilica read, "The Mother and Head of all the Churches of the City and the World."

When we celebrate the anniversary of the cathedral that is the mother of all others founded through the ages, we celebrate the Lord, who founded his Church in order to gather together in unity, under the crozier of Peter and his successors, all the children of God, wherever they may live.

Today's opening prayer puts it in perspective: "God our Father, from living stones, your chosen people, you built an eternal temple to your glory." We are the "living stones." We are "the chosen people." We are "the eternal temple" called to be Church. We are the ones who are called to have "zeal for (God's) house," as the Gospel put it. We are the ones who can fulfill our prophetic mission by evangelization.

Celebrate the Church today. Celebrate the domestic church, that church which is in your home. That is what we are really celebrating today. Although we all have many things to do today, take some time to enjoy each other. Spend time with each other. Grow in your relationship to other members of God's family.
