2. Know the candidates.

It's a terrible feeling to be in the voting booth and to feel like you're tossing a coin, hoping that the individual you're voting for stands for the right values. Of course, you can vote with a clear conscience if you *know for sure ahead of time where that candidate stands*. It is a moral obligation to do your homework to learn about the candidate, and the time is now, long before Election Day.

Candidates have websites you can visit, campaign headquarters you can call, and literature you can read. Also, candidates who already hold elected office in which they have voted on legislation *have a voting record*. That record is public information, some of which can be found at www.priestsforlife.org/legislation.
