#### Peace!

In our gospel for this Sunday we find Jesus explaining to his disciples the type of Messiah he would be. He will be arrested, he will suffer greatly at the hands of the elders, the chief priests and scribes, he will be put to death and on the third day he will be raised up. This must have caused a lot of disappointment to the disciples.

Peter who just made confession of the identity and mission of Jesus was rebuked by the Lord. Jesus told him, "Get behind me, Satan! You are an obstacle to me. You are judging not by God's standard but by human standard." Jesus reminds Peter and the other disciples to face him and his brand of Messiahship accordance with the Scriptures and in accordance with the will of God.

Our gospel then challenges us to follow and embrace Jesus' ways, to take up our cross, deny oneself and follow him. Only then will we become true disciples of Jesus, the Messiah, the Son of the living God.


