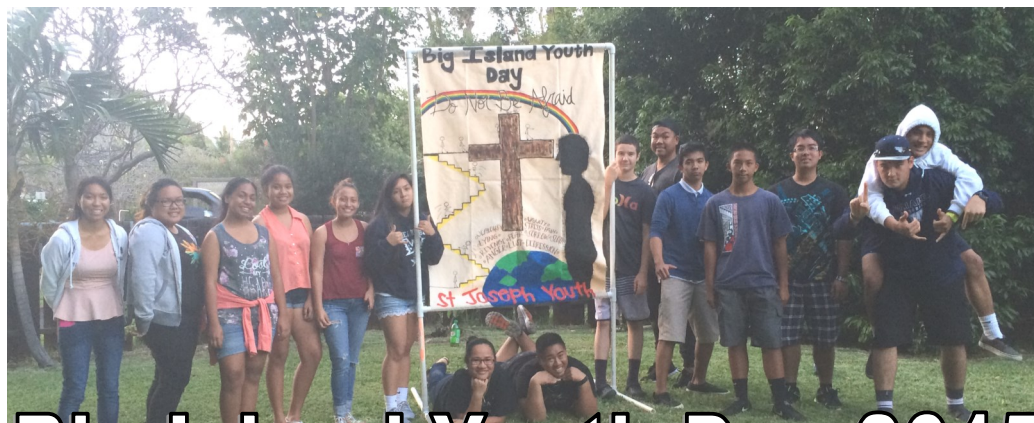
Alumni & Friends Luau Needs You!
