

## Pastor's Corner

## Fourth Sunday of Lent

Dear brothers and sisters

Peace!

How do we respond to God's mercy?



Looking at the first reading we see the infidelity of the people of Israel. It says, "All the princes of Judah, all the priests, and all the people added infidelity to infidelity, practicing all the abominations of the nations and polluting the Lord's temple..." We just can imagine the magnitude of the infidelity of ALL the people. And yet we see God's mercy. He sends messengers, the prophets, in order to remind the people of their vocation to be faithful to the covenant. But the people destroyed the lives of God's messengers and desecrated the temple. And it came to a point where the people had to bear the consequences of their infidelity. The temple was destroyed and they were thrown into exile.

Yet God's mercy asserts itself. God gave them an opportunity to go back to their homeland and to rebuild the temple and the holy city of Jerusalem. The mercy of God is manifested in his way of transcending his hurts and pains, his sorrows and humiliation he received from his own people.

God is faithful. We can trust his fidelity to us. Let us rejoice in this truth by being faithful to him as well.

If we truly desire to be faithful to God, let us look at Jesus on the cross who takes the punishment to himself. He was raised as one who loves us so much. His mercy is so great that his death becomes our salvation. "God so loved the world that he gave us his only Son, not to condemn the world but to give his life as a ransom for the many".




