Weekly Reflection:

#### 21th Sunday of Ordinary Time - Year A "But who do you say that I am?"

Today's society often judges a person by the image they project, thus for many projecting the right image has been the everyday battle regardless whether it is backed up by true substance or not. Perception has become more important than reality.

When Jesus asked in today's gospel "Who do men say that the Son of man is?", it was not because he was concerned about the image he is projecting. It was to check if people's perceptions coincided with reality - whether they really knew him or not. enough, they do not really know Him!

How about us? Do we really know who Jesus is? If we are asked by Jesus "But who do you say that I am?" how would we respond to such a question? Do we know him thru the books that we have read? Do we know him thru the homilies and seminars we have heard? Do we know him thru the blessings we have received? The question really is: " Have we really encountered Christ in our life?" And what difference has He made in us

And as the Gospel will tell us, Simon came up with the correct answer, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." And this is considered a grace, a revelation coming from God. And for recognizing Jesus as the Messiah, he is rewarded with a second name, Peter which means rock. By renaming him, Jesus gives us His pledge that Peter would like a rock that is strong, solid and enduring not because of his own merit but because of God's grace at work in him.

Let us pray that we be attentive to the many encounters with the Lord and really get to know him so that these encounters may shape our hearts and be drawn closer to Him.


