February 2nd – Feast of the Presentation of the Lord - 2025

Consecrated to the Lord

February 2nd is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. In today's Gospel, Joseph and Mary took the baby Jesus to the temple to present Him to the Lord. According to the ancient Jewish tradition, a child is never given to parents by God, but only lent to them. This tradition springs from God's instruction to Moses: "Every first-born male shall be consecrated to the Lord". This was an act of consecration, to acknowledge and thank the Lord for the gift of life, and to dedicate the child's whole life to what God has planned for the child.

Aside from the Holy Family, the two other people who have dedicated their whole lives to such a mission were Simeon and Anna, who awaited the coming of the Messiah. They spend a lifetime waiting and looking forward to the day that it will be fulfilled. The challenge is to hold on as time goes by and the original enthusiasm wanes. But Simeon and Anna keep their hopes alive. They nourished it with their prayer life. Only the strength of the Spirit could make them hold on through the years without losing hope.

We also will have the blessings of the candles in today's liturgy. The lighted candle symbolizes Jesus Christ who is the "light of revelation to all nations." But it also calls to mind Jesus' challenge to us in the Gospels that we too are meant to be the light of the world.

May our light burn brightly as we walk with the Lord.
