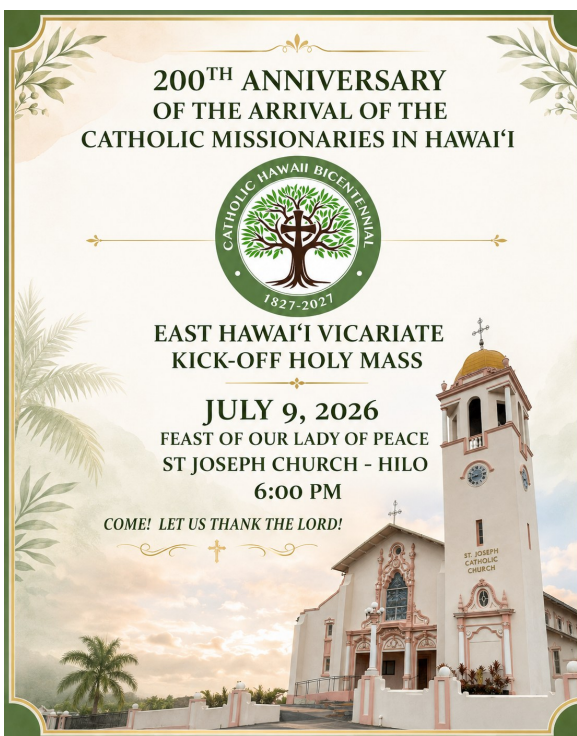

“...And I will give you rest”

Into this restless world, Jesus speaks these comforting words: **"Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest."**

At first, we might think Jesus is promising a life without problems. We imagine that if we follow Him, all our difficulties will disappear. But we know from experience that faithful Christians still become sick, lose loved ones, struggle with family problems, and carry heavy crosses.

So what kind of rest is Jesus offering? It is definitely not rest like taking a break from work or commitment, nor rest as freedom from suffering or responsibility. He promises something greater: a rest that springs from **His** presence in the midst of our burdens.

Many people today have comfortable homes, successful careers, and financial security, yet they remain restless. Others have very little materially, yet they possess an inner peace that nothing can take away. The difference is not what they possess but **Who possesses their hearts.**

Jesus offers the peace that comes from knowing that we are loved by God, forgiven of our sins, and never abandoned. He offers the assurance that our lives have meaning, that our suffering is not wasted, and that death is not the end.

St. Augustine expressed it perfectly: **"Our hearts are restless until they rest in You."**
