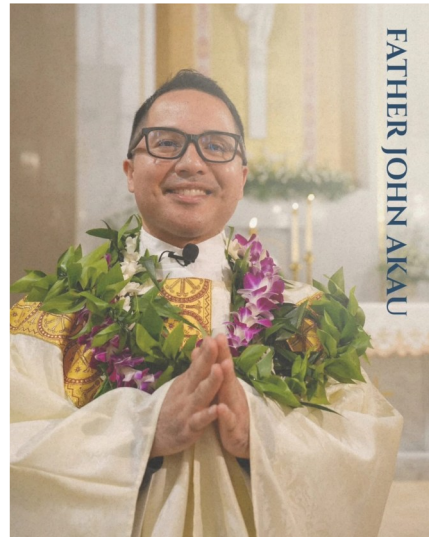

11th Sunday of Ordinary Time – 2026 (A)

At the sight of the crowds...

Today's Gospel begins with a beautiful description of the heart of Jesus:
"At the sight of the crowds, his heart was moved with pity for them, because they were troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd."

Before Jesus sends out the apostles on mission, He first looks upon the people with compassion. Mission begins not with a plan, a program, or a strategy. It begins with seeing people through the eyes of God.

Jesus sees beyond the crowds. He sees their wounds, fears, struggles, loneliness, and hunger. He recognizes that they are like sheep without a shepherd—people searching for meaning and hope.

The same is true today. Many people around us may appear successful and happy on the outside, but inside they may be carrying burdens that no one sees. There are many who feel lost, abandoned, discouraged, or disconnected from God. We are reminded that: before we can serve others, we must learn to see them as Jesus sees them.

And notice that before sending the disciples, Jesus tells them to pray. The mission belongs to God. The harvest belongs to God. We are merely His workers. Jesus reminds us that the harvest is abundant. God is already at work in people's hearts. He simply asks us to participate in His work.

The mission of the Church begins with the compassion of Christ. The more we encounter His love, the more we are sent to share that love with others.
